- 1) 2 suitcases, which should be of moderate size to aid storage, and an overnight bag. All items of luggage should be clearly named on the outside. A stout label should be attached to any keys.
- 2) Every article must be in good repair and marked (preferably with name tapes) with the boy's name and initials followed by IC (International College). This includes socks, shoes, slippers, etc. It is particularly requested that all winter games clothes should be visibly marked on the OUTSIDE. The School cannot be held responsible for loss, due to neglect of this rule. Any enquiries regarding mislaid clothing should be made to the matron. Pillowcases should be marked on the OUTSIDE; socks should be marked vertically and not horizontally.
- 3) Team players those representing the School may require additional sports kit, which should be marked with the boy's name and initials, followed by IC.
- 4) When College uniform is not required; pupils may wear **Formal Change or Standard Change**.

Formal Change: which every student must have available, means, a smart outfit of quiet design and neat appearance and could include a jacket. For both boys and girls, denim, leather, tee-shirts or shorts are NOT allowed. Girls skirts should be of a decent length. Formal Dress is to be worn for a particular trip or occasion as directed by staff.

Standard Change: means clothing that is clean, in good repair, and without embellishments of any sort. Everything must be of quiet design and neat appearance, and must not be provocative. It may be worn on occasions when neither College uniform nor Formal Change is required.
